HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RULES & GUIDELINES

Objectives:

- To encourage and recognize continuous music study of graduating high school seniors
- To encourage teacher participation in SDSC student programs
- To inspire current music students to continue their music lessons and participate in music programs offered by CAPMT San Diego South Chapter.

Monetary awards as determined by the Scholarship Committee can be used for private lessons, school expenses, music books, and/or instrument supplies. Applicants may or may not pursue music as their field of study in college.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Recommendation Letter from current teacher. Student must have studied with the teacher for at least 3 years. Teacher must be an active member of CAPMT District 1 San Diego South Chapter for at least 1 year. Submit recommendation letter to:
 - Email: sdsouthcapmt@gmail.com
 - Write in the Subject Heading: Scholarship Award Application Teacher Letter
- 2. Audition materials (see below)
- 3. Personal statement and essay, limit to 300-400 words.
 - Topic: "What Music Means to Me."
- 4. Application Form filled up and submitted online on or before the deadline,

Music Audition Guidelines

- 1. Students must perform on their instrument two solo works of contrasting style.
- 2. Audition materials approximately 7-10 mins in total duration.
- 3. Repertoire pieces must be performed from memory and must showcase the student's skill and ability.
- 4. Performances must be recorded live, unedited, uploaded online, and no more than 6 months old before the application deadline. The recordings must be made by a single camera, with the performer's whole silhouette, feet and hands visible.

- 6. Label the uploaded files with the name of the student, title of the repertoire selections, and composers.
